### Minutes

Emilie moved and Nikki seconded to approve the minutes from the January 15, 2020, meeting as presented. Approved.

### Treasurer's Report

Nikki moved and Katie seconded to approve the treasurer's report as provided. Approved.

### Principal's Report

Sixth and eighth grades have participated in the NHD competition and winners are moving on to the state competition.

February 27-28 is the variety show, plus there will be a matinee for the kids.

Boundary discussions continue. There are currently four proposals. In two of those, the honors program moves to Patrick Henry; the final decision, however, is an administrative decision and not a committee decision. The committee is aiming for approximately 1000 kids per middle school. Currently 36-38% of Edison students are on free/reduced lunch. One plan has that number increased to 58%. On April 9, there will be a community boundary discussion at Edison. The boundary discussion meetings are available on the school district website.

The math curriculum is changing again next year back to a 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> blend so no grade levels are skipped and no curricula missed.

There are currently about 1130 students at Edison, with projections for next year at about 1170. Currently there are 8 teachers on a cart without a classroom. Open enrollment requests will be considered soon.

The library is still working on flexible seating. Yearbook donated \$15,000 to the library.

### New Business

Conference meals went pretty well. Some people signed up to bring items and never brought them. The book fair went well and all volunteers showed up.

Chill on the Hill took place on February 11 and went very well.
