

Edison PTO Meeting Minutes - Amended (1/17/19)

December 19th, 2018

Meeting Attendees: Karen Walters, Emilie Yu, Mr. Hieronimus, Melissa Nelson

Call to Order: Karen called meeting to order with welcome and distribution of minutes from November meeting.

Motion made to approve November minutes by Emilie Ng, seconded by Melissa Nelson

Treasurer Report: Emilie reviewed the budget and explained the change in budget format to make the report easier to read. The outstanding spirit wear bill was paid as well as 1/2 the student allocation expense.

Principal's Report: Mr. Hieronimus shared that MAP assessments were finished and a 2 hour late start schedule was used during testing to allow enough time for students to complete tests. March 1st is the National Assessment of Educational Progress(NAP). This is a random selection of schools and students as determined by the state. About 190 8th grade students will randomly be selected to complete assessments in reading, math and science. *Edison was randomly selected for this national assessment. The 150 8th grade Edison students that took the assessment were also randomly selected.* Also, vape information was included in the recent Edison Echo to create awareness. The vape violation policy is the same as the tobacco violation policy.

Counselor's Report: An expansion packet proposal has been submitted to IPC to address the need for an additional counselor at Edison. Mid March is the earliest that school staff will know if this will be approved.

Old Business:

Chill on the Hill: Scheduled for Jan. 22 & 24 from 4-7pm. \$2 cost per/student. This event is for tubing only. PTO covers remainder of the cost for buses and tubes. Sign up genius will go out for parent volunteers for this event.

Chip Shoppe Fundraiser: Total profit was \$7500 and is very similar to last years profit. Discussed adjusting logistics for pick up for next year.

New Business:

Spring Conferences: Feb. 7,12,14 Conferences will be in the evenings and are moving into the classrooms to allow for greater confidentiality. Communication will be forthcoming as to how this will work. Meals will be provided for staff and a sign up genius will be sent out to coordinate this.
