Minutes

Treasurer's Report

Kristina Sipma presented the Treasurer's Report. The Performance Budget to date is posted on the Edisonsf.org website. Total income to date is \$17,829.52 and total expenses to date are \$4,419.87. The current checkbook balance is \$22,875.61. A motion was made by LeAnn Minister to approve the budget as presented and was seconded by Margaret Preston.

Principal's Report

Amber Blume gave the principal's report about some upcoming events at Edison. The Kindness Club has planned activities and dress up days for celebrating National Kindness week. Parent Teacher conferences will be coming up on February 10th and 15th. In person conferences will be on the 10th and online conferences will be on the 15th. NAEP testing for 8th graders will be on February 7th.

Old Business

Catalog Sales update by Nikki Schmaltz. A few customers have not received all of their products yet. The catalog company is having supply chain issues. Due to these difficulties, the PTO may want to look at doing a different fundraiser next year.

New Business

The bookfair will be set up during conferences in February. The times and dates have not yet been set. The librarians and some of the teachers will be able to use Scholastic money to buy books for classrooms and the library.

Spiritwear will also be for sale during the bookfair. Angela Gosch is working on setting up another online spiritwear sale with a new company.

It was decided that for the upcoming conference meals we will plan to set up a taco bar and a soup meal for the staff. A Sign-up Genius will be sent out to parents.

The 5th grade welcome meeting for parents and students will be this spring. Dates have not been set yet. Amber Blume will let the PTO know when the dates have been chosen. In the past, PTO has sold spiritwear and talked about the Edison PTO at the Parent Night for 5th graders.

Amber Blume reported that the Student Council would like to have a school dance. Nikki Schmaltz will get in contact with Student Council leader Erin Larson. Amber and Erin will choose a date for sometime in March or April. PTO will need to help provide funds for a DJ and the Student Council students could do most of the other planning and set up.

All of the PTO board positions for next year have now been filled. LeAnn Minister will be co-president. Margaret Preston agreed to fill the other co-president position. Also staying on the board will be Kristina Sipma as treasurer, Shannon Huber as secretary, and Angela Gosch as spiritwear coordinator. Someone has been found to fill the bookfair position.

The next PTO meeting will be February 16th at noon on zoom.
