Total income to date is \$23,469 and total expenses to date are \$14,994. The current checkbook balance is \$22,229. On Monday February 13, there was \$275 of Spirit Wear sales and \$1,000 in Book Fair sales. There has been \$550 collected on CheddarUp for conference meals.
