

Edison PTO Meeting Minutes

March 20th, 2019

Call to Order: Karen called meeting to order with welcome and distribution of minutes from January meeting.

Motion made to approve November minutes by Shelly SHorr, seconded by Emilie Ng

Principal's Report: Mr. Hieronimus shared that enrollment projections for the 2019/2020 school year is 1092 students. This is an increase of 15 students with the breakdowns expected to be as follows: 6th grade - 361, 7th grade 380, 8th grade 343. The bid for the painting came back at \$3000 for both murals in the cafeteria and banner above the lockers in the hallway. Colors will be gray & maroon and this will help create a cohesive look and feel through the school. The painting will likely happen this summer. Edison was identified by the state as 1 of several schools not meeting standards in certain subgroups. This is based on accountability calculations in the areas of student performance, student progress, English language learners progress and attendance. Due to this, the state is giving identified schools money to put towards targeted support and improvements. Edison will get \$28000 to put toward professional development and already has plans for additional staff training on MAP testing as well as a professional development conference that some of the staff will be attending. This information for Edison as well as any other SF school can be viewed on the SD Department of Education website. This is public information to view a schools report card.
