

## September 21, 2022 Edison PTO Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 12:00 by LeAnn Minister.

LeAnn Minister introduced this year's PTO officers and gave an overview of the PTO role at Edison.

### Minutes

The minutes from the May 18, 2022 meeting were approved. The motion was made by LeAnn Minister and was seconded by Peg Preston. The minutes for all the meetings are posted on the Edisonsf.org website.

### Principal's Report

Amber Blume gave the Principal's report. There are currently 915 students enrolled at Edison this year. A new Assistant Principal joined Edison this school year. Her name is Kelli Kallas and she comes to Edison from Patrick Henry Middle school. The theme for the staff and students this year is Dream and is based on the Dream characteristics from last year. There are 250 students involved in fall sports at Edison this year.

The Edison Extra program will be continued again this school year. This program is intended for students who need some extra help with their school work. On Tuesday and Thursday mornings before school there will be teachers available to help students. There will be a new Lunch Study program this year. The Lunch Study is for students who have 3 or more missing assignments and they will have time to go work on completing assignments so they don't fall too far behind. Fall parent teacher conferences are coming up. There will be virtual conferences on Tuesday, October 4th and in person conferences on Thursday, October 6th.

### Treasurer's Report

LeAnn Minister presented the Treasurer's Report. The Proposed Budget for the school year was shared on the Zoom screen and is also posted on the Edison.org website. We are starting the year with a checkbook balance of \$13,754.15. The total proposed expenses for the year is \$24,075 and the proposed estimated income is \$19,250. Amber Blume confirmed that there will be no Pride cards this year and instead the school will continue with the PBIS incentive program. The PTO will make a donation to the PBIS store again this year. The motion to approve the Proposed Budget was made by Peg Preston and seconded by Shannon Huber.

### New Business

LeAnn Minister presented information related to this year's Color Run. Discussion occurred on some different possibilities for the race. We are using a new fundraising company called Boosterthon so there will be some changes to the Color Run this year. This will be the main fundraiser for PTO this year and it is a fun activity for the students. There will be no spring sales fundraiser. The Student Council has agreed to be involved by doing some of the MC work before the race and Amber agreed to MC the big color blast at the end. Since the DJ from last year is quoting a large price increase from last year, we are looking for anyone who has access to some speakers and a microphone that we could use.

Conference meals this year for the teachers will be Jimmy John's on October 4th and soup for the October 6th conferences. There will be a Sign-up Genius sent out asking for soups, sides, and monetary donations to cover these two meals.

Angela Gosch discussed the spirit wear sales. She would like to try selling spirit wear at a couple of the afterschool sports activities. Amber Blume recommended finding a night where a couple of sports are going on at the same time. There will also be spirit wear sales at fall conferences.
